Bible Story: God's Wonderful Surprise*

{The Resurrection from Matt 28, Mark 16, Luke 24, John 20}

Yes, but whoever said anything about the end?

Just before sunrise, on the third day, God sent an earthquake - and an angel from heaven. When the guards saw the angel, they fell down with fright. The angel rolled the huge stone away, sat on top of it, and waited.

At the first glimmer of dawn, Mary Magdalene and other women headed to the tomb to wash Jesus' body. 

- 1. What is one thing you are absolutely certain of about dinner tonight? ("It's going to be great!" "I'll definitely have to eat my vegetables.")
- 2. If you need help, on whom can you call? Name 3 people that you are confident would help you.
- 3. Name one thing that you are really confident that you can do all by yourself. Name one thing that you want to do but don't have enough confidence quite yet.
- 4. The Easter story shows us that Jesus came back to life to show us that He can beat anything even death! How can that story give us confidence?
- 5. John 3: 16 says "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son that whoever believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life." Why did God send Jesus for you? How does God's love give us confidence?

 - b. stays in the air the longest.

















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
Game On!Traveling Flat Pat

- Have a parent post a picture on Facebook and/or Instagram using #RISEUP4Christ.



I don't know about you, but I love Easter. It's the Super Bowl of my faith, so to speak. It's a time I can reflect and celebrate how Jesus demonstrated his love for each one of us in the most incredible way!

I love to remind my kids that God loves us no matter what. As much as we try to do the right thing, we will never be perfect. When Jesus was on earth, He was perfect, but the people around Him didn't even realize it. Those people actually punished Him, and Jesus did not fight against that punishment. He accepted it and He died. So Easter is when we celebrate that Jesus took a punishment He didn't deserve and He died on a cross. BUT, the joy and celebration came three days later, when He arose from the dead! Jesus gave up his life so that we could spend eternity with God.
